### **Public Comment**

Jeff updated the board on a meeting he had in Janesville on the drug units and health care for drug users.

Clerk Tollefson updated the board on the temporary right of way permit for the Dan Silha permit to the driveway to enter Kennedy Road.

Supervisor J. Klenz mentioned that he had talked with Advanced Disposal on droppings that happened during the trash collection the previous week,

### **Request to lower speedlimit on Rotamer Rd from Henke to Townhall RD**

### **Farmland Preservation ordinance**

Attorney Moore updated the board on what had changed with the State of Wisconsin on what is required for the new farmland preservation ordinance that needs to be completed by Dec 31, 2017 including what can be done with a CUP, building sizes for accessory buildings and such. This will be discussed at the next few meetings.
