

**TOWN OF HARMONY
ORDINANCE NO. 121222**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF CHAPTER 11 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF HARMONY RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING RESTRICTIONS THROUGHOUT THE TOWN.

The Town of Harmony, County of Rock, State of Wisconsin ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 11 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Harmony is hereby amended to state as follows:

Section 3. No Parking Zones. The following portions of Town roads are hereby designated as “No Parking” or “Restricted Parking” areas and road signs shall be posted at the following locations to indicate said restrictions:

1. E. Morgan Way;
2. N. Colt Drive;
3. N. Galaxy Drive;
4. N. Lunar Drive;
5. E. Saturn Drive;
6. N. Polaris Parkway;
7. Apollo Lane; and
8. E. Rotamer Road, near Spaulding’s Pond.

No person shall leave or park a motor vehicle contrary to any sign posted by the Town of Harmony indicating “No Parking” or “Restricted Parking” on any Town road.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon posting of this Ordinance as required by law.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.80 (5), Notice is hereby given of the passage of Town of Harmony Ordinance No. 121222 by the Town Board on December 12, 2022. Said Ordinance is summarized as follows:

- (1) The Ordinance amends Section 3 of Chapter 11 relating to motor vehicle parking restrictions within the Town.
- (2) The Ordinance, as amended prohibits parking in designated areas on portions of E. Morgan Way, N. Colt Drive, N. Galaxy Drive, N. Lunar Drive, E. Saturn Drive, N. Polaris Parkway, Apollo Lane, and E. Rotamer Road.
